Fellowship

Comcast established the fellowship with the Department of Telecommunications (TCOM) at Ball State University for a student who will work up to 15 hours per week providing video services to Comcast Cable and be responsible to Comcast.

Fellowship amount: \$2000
Academic year 2019-2020

Criteria

- Must be a major in Telecommunications at Ball State and be actively enrolled at the time of application.
- Must have a minimum GPA in TCOM of 3.0 and an overall GPA of 3.0 at the time of application.
- Must have sophomore (30+ credits) or junior (60+ credits) standing at the time of application.
- Must provide 2 letters of support indicating you have the skill sets to work in a media environment.
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student (at least 12 credits) at Ball State for the Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 semesters and must be available to work for Comcast up to 15 hours per week in both the Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 semesters.
- The recipient of this award will be a member of the Student Advisory Council (SAC) and must be available for SAC meetings.
- Must provide a web/Vimeo/You Tube site or DVD/CD displaying the applicant's audio and/or video work.
- Recipient will be awarded \$1000 per semester to student's bursar's account.

Submit an application package to TCOM Dept. BC201 containing:

- TCOM scholarship application form
- A current DegreeWorks Audit
- Your **current** resume
- A 1-2 page typed (double spaced) essay about yourself (background, activities, aspirations)
- Evidence of financial need also may be submitted.
